ANNOUNCEMENT

The European Acoustics Association (EAA) will, according to its objectives, promote the active participation of young researchers and students at the **EAA EUROREGIO 2010, integrating the First Forum of Young Researchers, to be held in Ljubljana from 13 to 18 September 2010** with grants and awards.

A. GRANTS FOR YOUNG RESEARCHERS PARTICIPATING IN THE EAA SUMMER SCHOOL

EAA and COST (European Cooperation in Science and Technology) projects will support with grants the participation of a limited number of European young researchers and students in the EAA Summer School, as part of the First Forum of Young Researchers. The grant includes **free registration** for the summer school (with participation in the congress included).

To apply for these grants, young researchers must be:

- a) enrolled to a university course (Master, PhD) or already have a Master or a PhD degree
- b) no more than 35 years old on 01.01.2010
- c) citizen of one of the European countries that is a member of EAA

Interested young researchers **must register for the summer school indicating which courses they plan to attend (at least two courses of their choice)** on the congress website <http://www.fs.uni-lj.si/sda/euroregio.htm> and in parallel **send** their application in electronic form to the General Secretary of EAA secretary@european-acoustics.net and to the General Secretary of EAA EUROREGIO jurij.prezeli@fs.uni-lj.si

before **30 May 2010**

Young researchers enrolled in the summer school must also attend the structured sessions related to the topics of the summer school courses.

The application must include the following documents (in pdf format):

- a) university enrolment certificate (for Master or PhD students)
- b) copy of the university degree (for other young researchers)
- c) birth and citizenship certificate or a passport copy
- d) letter of support from the supervisor

The Board of the European Acoustics Association, on the basis of the received applications, will publish a list of winners of the grants **before 30 June 2010** on the EAA web site www.eaa-fenestra.org and will inform the winners accordingly.

B. EAA BEST PAPER AND PRESENTATION AWARDS FOR YOUNG RESEARCHERS

The EAA will offer six Best Paper and Presentation Awards to young researchers who will present a paper as first author at the EAA EUROREGIO 2010 Conference.

AWARD AMOUNT:
500 €

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible to the “Best Paper and Presentation Award” the young researcher must:

- a) be no more than 35 years old on 01.01.2010.
- b) be the first author of the submitted abstract and full paper
- c) present the paper at the meeting (oral or poster presentation)

SELECTION:

The award winners will be selected by a jury nominated by the Board of the European Acoustics Association. The selection will be based upon the quality of both the content of the paper and its presentation. The awards will be announced either at the conference or after the closing of the conference.

APPLICATION:

All those who wish to participate in the competition for the EAA Best Paper and Presentation Awards must indicate their intention by sending an e-mail, to the General Secretary of EAA secretary@european-acoustics.net and to the General Secretary of EAA EUROREGIO jurij.prezeli@fs.uni-lj.si with the subject line: *For EAA Best Paper Award*
